



SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY FACT SHEET

Youth must meet at least ONE eligibility factor:

- Youth with Limited English Proficiency
- Youth performs at one grade level or more below average or is basic skills deficient
- Youth is enrolled in an alternative learning program
- Youth has a physical, mental, emotional or learning disability
- Youth has an IEP
- Family receives public assistance
- Youth is eligible for FREE school lunch (not reduced)
- Youth is or was chemically dependent or is a child of drug or alcohol abusers/dependents
- Youth is receiving Group Home Services
- Youth is in foster care
- Youth is an actual or potential school dropout
- Youth is pregnant/parenting
- Youth is a juvenile offender/diversion program
- Youth is homeless/runaway
- Family income is below the state-mandated poverty line for corresponding family size

NOTE: Eligibility requirements are subject to change as dictated by funding sources.

Additional Criteria

Males 18 and older must be registered with the Selective Service before submitting an application to work in our government-funded program. They must register at <http://sss.gov>

All youth must include a copy of their social security card with their completed application. Youth who are not U.S. citizens must include a copy of their R.A. card.

Youth must also meet age and residency requirements. We can only employ youth ages 14 - 21 who RESIDE in Dakota, suburban Hennepin, and Washington counties.
