Job Purpose: Build skills for a meaningful career through hands-on, project-based learning in tree care and landscaping. Develop technical and transferrable skills while making our community a greener, healthier place to live. Earn industry-recognized credential(s) and gain employment readiness skills.

Job Summary: Develop skills for green industry careers with other young adults (18-25) in a safe, professional environment. This sixteen-week on-the-job training involves completing community-based projects and curriculum, while developing additional employment readiness skills that will be applicable to both outdoor and office settings. Led by a Crew Leader, Crew Members will complete projects for tree care and landscaping.

What you will get from this role:

- An hourly wage of \$12.50/hour working 28 hours per week, Monday Thursday.
- You will build skills for a meaningful career through hands-on, project-based learning in tree care and/or landscaping.
- You will develop technical and transferrable skills while making our community a greener, healthier place to live.
- You will earn industry-recognized credentials to gain a competitive edge over other applicants when applying for future jobs.
- You will have a dedicated team who will provide support services, job coaching, and career exploration opportunities.
- Introduction to employers in the green industry that need workers.

Essential Functions:

- Assist the Crew Leader in tree care and landscaping projects including tree planting, felling, pruning, mulching, watering, conducting tree inventories, invasive species and diseased tree removal, mowing, and property maintenance.
- Cooperate with fellow crew members and supervisors to accomplish work project goals with a commitment to quality.
- Follow worksite safety guidelines and training for operating tools and equipment, identifying hazards, and using personal protective equipment.
- Master basic tree care and/or landscaping competencies including proper tool identification and use, terminology and vocabulary, methods of tree care and landscaping, and material identification and use.
- Learn industry-recognized curriculum to achieve credentials in tree care and/or landscaping.

Skills Required:

- Commitment to maintaining focus on program mission and goals to learn a skilled trade while improving the community.
- Willingness to demonstrate a strong work ethic, good attendance, and positive attitude.
- Ability to listen to constructive feedback to develop technical and transferrable skills.

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Qualifications Required:

- Must be between 18-25 years of age on the start date of the employment training program (Monday, September 13)
- High school diploma or GED
- Valid driver's permit or license by program start date (Monday, September 13) is preferred

Work Environment: Regularly works outside in various weather conditions that include extreme high or low temperatures, depending on the season. Noise level may be loud at times. Sturdy/closed toe footwear required. All tools provided by Tree Trust.

Physical demands:

- Ability to be outdoors and to work amongst a team in various weather conditions.
- Ability to stand for long periods, sit, twist, bend, grip, and lift and carry heavy objects up to 50 lbs.
- Willingness to appropriately wear personal protective equipment.
- Ability to learn how to safely and effectively use all tools and equipment needed for job tasks, including potentially operating a chainsaw and/or other landscaping and tree care equipment.
